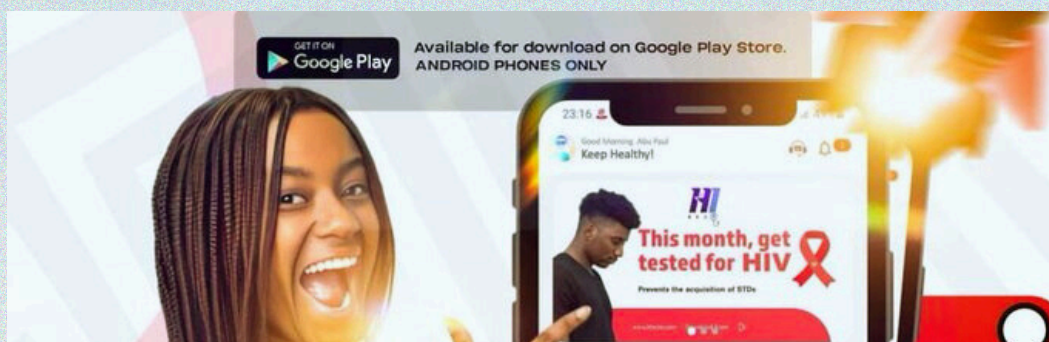
Osun 2025 LG Election Crisis

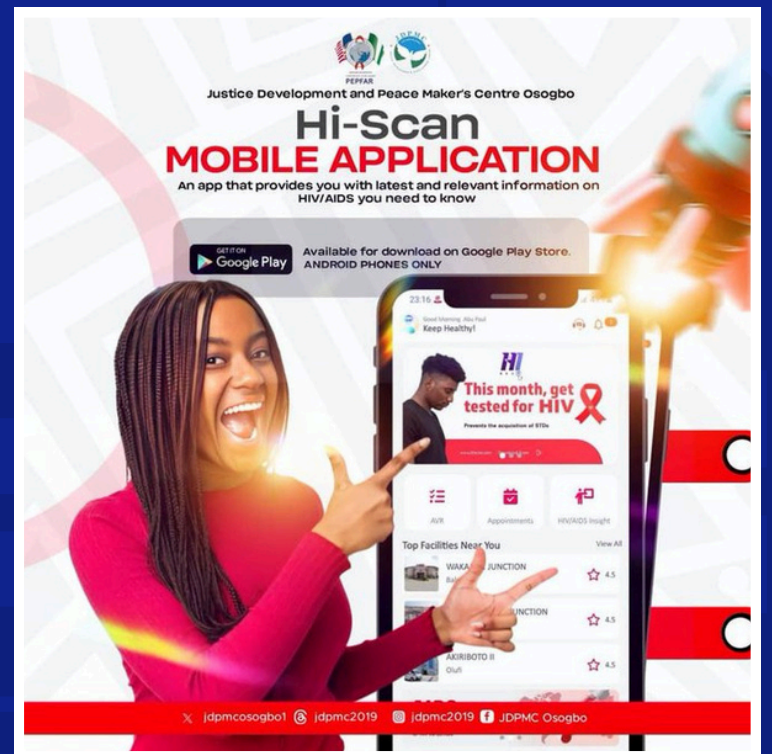
HI Scan Mobile App Launching for Sensitization
